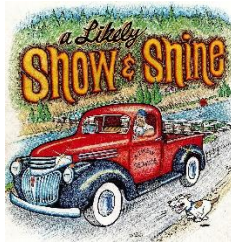




# Likely Matters

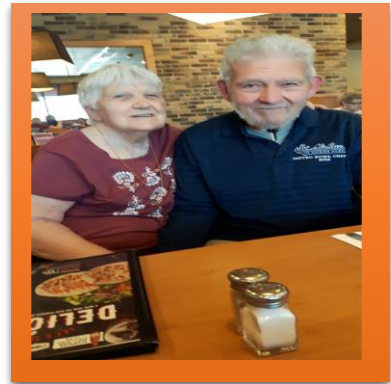
